**COMES NOW** Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) and for its *Notice of Mailing* states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On September 24, 2025, MAWC filed an *Application and Motion for Waiver* (“Application”) requesting authority from the Commission to purchase the water and sewer utility assets of the City of Neosho, Missouri (“Neosho”), and permission, approval and a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain water and sewer systems for the public in an area in an around Neosho, Missouri.

2. Pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-50.060 (2) and 20 CSR 4240-60.050 (2), MAWC provided notice within twenty (20) days of filing the Application to all potential customers within the Neosho service area as set forth in the Application. The notice attached hereto as **Appendix A** was mailed on October 8, 2025.

Dear Neosho Resident:

Missouri American Water would like to inform you that on September 24, 2025, the Company filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (MoPSC) Certificates of Convenience and Necessity associated with the potential purchase of the City of Neosho's water and wastewater systems for \$34.5 million.

The MoPSC acquisition review process typically lasts between 6 to 12 months. If approved, the water and wastewater assets and customer base will be transferred to Missouri American Water to become the service provider for Neosho.

As part of the agreement and subject to MoPSC approval of the purchase, Missouri American Water has committed to investing approximately \$35 million in water and wastewater system improvements in the first five years of ownership.

Missouri American Water has proposed to keep both water and wastewater rates the same as the City of Neosho's rates at the time of closing. This is pending approval by the MoPSC. Any changes to future rates after closing would take place following a rate review request from Missouri American Water and approval from the MoPSC, a process that typically takes 11 months.
