**NOTICE THAT TARIFF WILL BE ALLOWED TO GO INTO EFFECT
AND ORDER DIRECTING STAFF REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION**

Issue Date: October 29, 2025

Effective Date: November 1, 2025

On October 17, 2025, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a tariff sheet to reflect changes in the company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA). Those changes are a result of estimated changes in the cost of natural gas and changes in the Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factors. The tariff sheet bears an effective date of November 1, 2025, and has been assigned Tracking No. JG-2026-0057.

The change on the Total PGA rate applicable to Ameren Missouri's service areas will increase to 64.94¢/Ccf¹ from 60.38¢/Ccf for firm sales customers. The interruptible sales customers' PGA will increase to 45.08¢/Ccf from 39.09¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The Staff of the Commission (“Staff”) filed its verified recommendation on October 24, 2025. No other party has filed a response to Ameren Missouri’s filing. Staff recommended approving the tariff on an interim basis, subject to refund, pending final Commission decisions in ACA Case No. GR-2026-0083 and ACA Case No. GR-2025-0101. The Staff Procurement Analysis Department stated it will review Ameren

Missouri's ACA filing and requests permission to submit its results and recommendations on or before December 15, 2026.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation. Based on the verified filings, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff sheet conforms to Ameren Missouri's Commission-approved PGA Clause. The Commission will allow the tariff sheet to go into effect by operation of law, to establish rates on an interim basis, subject to refund, for service on and after November 1, 2025. The Commission will direct Staff to review the information included in this ACA filing and submit its results and recommendations.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff sheet (P.S.C. Mo. No. 2, 125th Revised Sheet No. 30, Cancelling P.S.C. Mo. No. 2, 124th Revised Sheet No. 30), Tracking No. JG-2026-0057, will be allowed to go into effect by operation of law on November 1, 2025, to establish rates on an interim basis, subject to refund, through the Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) process, for service on and after November 1, 2025.
2. Staff shall review the information included in this ACA filing and submit its results and recommendations no later than December 15, 2026.
3. This order shall be effective on November 1, 2025.

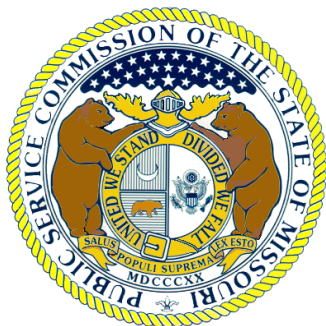
