### ORDER WAIVING RULE PROVISION

Issue Date: October 29, 2025 Effective Date: October 29, 2025

On April 21, 2025,<sup>1</sup> Environmental Utilities, LLC filed a letter requesting an increase in its annual water system operating revenues. On April 25, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a *Small Utility Rate Case Timeline* pursuant to the staff assisted rate case procedure under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.075.

On September 17, Staff filed its *Notice of Rate Case Timeline Extension*, as allowed by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.075(5)(A), extending the 150-day deadline to file a disposition agreement or request for a hearing<sup>2</sup> to October 17.

On October 17, Staff filed a *Motion for Waiver*, requesting a waiver for good cause of the October 17<sup>th</sup> deadline pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.075(15) and stating their intention to file a procedural schedule or status report by October 31.

No parties responed to Staff's motion within the time set by the Commission. The Commission finds good cause to waive the rule.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.075(11) requiring the filing of a disposition agreement or request for a hearing no later than 150 days after the opening

of the case (plus an extension of 30 days, as agreed to by the parties, and allowed by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.075(5)(A)), is waived for good cause shown, pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.075(15).

- 2. Staff shall file a status report, disposition agreement, or request for a hearing no later than October 31, 2025.
  - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
