## ORDER GRANTING MISSOURI-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY'S APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On September 3, 2010, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a tariff designed to increase its annual revenues for electric service. The Commission suspended that tariff and established September 27 as the deadline for interested parties to apply to intervene.

Missouri-American Water Company filed its application to intervene on September 27. Missouri-American is a Missouri public utility that provides water and sewer service in various parts of Missouri, including areas that receive electric service from Ameren Missouri. Missouri-American uses a large amount of electricity supplied by Ameren Missouri, and in addition, as a Missouri utility, has an interest in the Commission's decision in this case. More than ten days have passed since Missouri-American applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that Missouri-American's interest in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing Missouri-American to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Application to Intervene of Missouri-American Water Company is granted.
2. This order shall become effective on October 8, 2010.
