The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the Motion to Strike Pre-Filed Testimony and Reject Tariffs and Motion for Expedited Treatment ("second motion") as to the request for a response from Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L").

The Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC"), the Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG"), and Staff ("movants") filed the second motion on July 6, 2012. Movants make several requests, including an expedited determination on certain pending tariff sheets, and a correspondingly expedited response to the motion from KCP&L. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion as to an expedited response from KCP&L.

Also, an identically-titled first motion¹ is awaiting the Commission's ruling. The two motions offer different citations for the tariff sheets at issue. Therefore, the Commission will order movants to file a response to this order, setting forth a comprehensive list of the testimony and tariff sheets at issue in both motions.
