**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE,
AND DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On November 5, 2025, Spire Missouri Inc. (Spire) filed an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage equipment and facilities for the production, processing, pipeline interconnection, and distribution of renewable natural gas (RNG). The project will consist of construction of a biogas upgrading facility, a meter and regulation interconnect, and a transmission pipeline to Spire’s distribution system – all of which would be constructed/installed in Jackson County, Missouri. The project would capture biogas generated by a City of Kansas City wastewater treatment plant, clean the biogas, and inject the resulting RNG into Spire’s western distribution system.

In its application, Spire also requests waiver of the Commission’s rule requiring 60 days’ notice prior to filing an application.¹

The Commission will direct notice of the application be given to the Jackson County Commission and local media. The Commission will set a deadline for interested

parties to intervene and direct its Staff to file a recommendation with regard to the application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order and the application to the County Commission of Jackson County, Missouri.
2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order and the application available to the media of Jackson County, Missouri.
3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than November 25, 2025.
4. No later than December 22, 2025, Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Spire's application or an alternative pleading.
5. This order is effective when issued.
