**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE,
AND DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On November 5, 2025, Spire Missouri Inc. (Spire) filed an application for approval of a renewable nature gas (RNG) program, pursuant to Section 386.895, RSMo, and Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-40.100. The program includes a qualified investment in RNG infrastructure – a biogas upgrading facility, a meter and regulation interconnect, and a transmission pipeline to Spire’s distribution center (collectively, the “Project”) – the costs of which Spire would seek recovery through a Renewable Natural Gas Rate Adjustment Mechanism. Concurrent with this application, in Case No. GA-2026-0121, Spire has filed an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) to construct and operate the Project, which would capture biogas generated by a City of Kansas City wastewater treatment plant, clean the biogas, and inject the resulting RNG into Spire’s western distribution system.

In its application, Spire also requests waiver of the Commission’s rule requiring 60 days’ notice prior to filing an application.¹

The Commission will direct notice of the application be given to media covering Spire's Missouri service territory. The Commission will set a deadline for interested parties to intervene and direct its Staff to file a recommendation with regard to the application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order and the application available to the media covering Spire's service territory in the state of Missouri.
2. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than November 25, 2025.
3. No later than December 22, 2025, Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Spire's application or an alternative pleading.
4. This order is effective when issued.
