On October 1, 2021, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2021 Integrated Resource Plan Annual Update, as it is required to do by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(3). Along with its Update, Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking that the Commission make all parties to the case established to consider that company’s 2020 Triennial Integrated Resource Plan – EO-2021-0021 – parties to this case so that Ameren Missouri may share confidential information with them subject to the protections afforded by the Commission’s regulation.

The Commission will add those parties to this case.
