SIERRA CLUB’S POSITION STATEMENT

COMES NOW, Sierra Club and for its Position Statement states as follows:

Sierra Club believes that the Corrected Non-Unanimous Global Stipulation and Agreement filed on November 9, 2025 (“Global Stipulation”) reasonably resolves all issues in this case. As such, Sierra Club respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Global Stipulation.

Sierra Club believes that any adopted tariff must ensure that large load customers do not encumber other customers with incremental cost or risk and also pay their fair share of the cost of the generation and transmission needed to meet their energy and capacity demands. In Sierra Club’s view, the Global Stipulation adequately insulates Ameren from stranded asset risk incurred in highly concentrated large-load customers, provides that large-load customers mitigate the costs that they cause on Ameren’s system, and provides a means by which these customers can procure clean energy to meet their goals while also benefiting all of Ameren's customers at no direct cost to non-large load customers.
