ORDER SETTING TIME FOR RESPONSES

On April 18, 2024, Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc. (Confluence Rivers) filed an application regarding the unregulated sewer assets of Barbara E. Rampone located in and around the Timber Ridge subdivision in Johnson County, MO. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) was ordered to file a recommendation regarding the application.

On September 23, 2024, Staff requested the Commission suspend its order for a recommendation. The suspension was requested to allow Confluence Rivers to amend its application to address issues raised by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources regarding the proposed rates in the application.

On November 7, 2025, Confluence Rivers filed a *Motion for Leave to Amend Application* (Motion). The Motion explains that Timber Ridge customers are not currently charged for sewer service. Confluence Rivers' Motion proposed to charge a rate equal to its approved District 1 rate of \$60.21 per month, which is Confluence Rivers' rate for systems with limited treatment technology. This rate proposal is different than the rate proposed in Confluence Rivers' initial application.

The change in proposed rates plus a request to amend Appendix F-C, the feasibility study associated with the project, constitutes Confluence Rivers' requested amendments to its application. The Commission will set a time for responses to the Motion.

The Commission will also order its Staff (Staff) to file a pleading indicating a date when its recommendation on Confluence Rivers' application as amended could be expected.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Responses to the *Motion for Leave to Amend Application* shall be filed no later than November 17, 2025.
2. No later than November 17, 2025, the Commission's Staff shall file a pleading indicating a date when it expects to be able to file its recommendation.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.

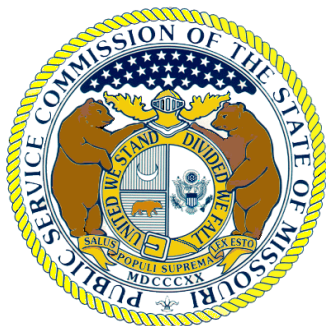
