PROTECTIVE ORDER

On April 14, 2022, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty (Liberty) filed its 2021 Renewable Energy Standard (RES) Compliance Report and 2022 RES Compliance Plan. Liberty filed portions of that Report and Plan as confidential, and other portions as highly confidential. Along with the Report and Plan, Liberty filed a motion asking the Commission to issue a protective order for additional protection to commercially sensitive information regarding materials subject to contractual agreements for nondisclosure. Liberty seeks leave to designate that information as Highly Confidential as permitted by the Commission's confidential information rule, 20 CSR 4240-2.135(4).

On April 15, 2022, the Commission issued its order establishing time to respond to Liberty's motion for protective order, requiring responses no later than April 20, 2022. That time has passed and no party has objected to Liberty's request for a protective order. The Commission will grant the request. The specific extra protections to be afforded to the information designated by Liberty as highly confidential are described in this order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Competitively sensitive information designated by Liberty as highly confidential shall be disclosed only to attorneys of record for all parties, to state agency parties and their employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, and to

designated outside experts of any non-state agency party.

- 2. Except for attorneys of record for all parties, and state agency employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, all persons authorized to access "confidential" information in this case shall complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit A.
- 3. Except for attorneys of record for all parties, and state agency employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, all persons authorized to access "highly confidential" information in this case shall complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit B.
- 4. Persons afforded access to materials or information designated "highly confidential" shall neither use nor disclose such materials or information for purposes of business or competition or any other purpose other than in regard to this case and shall keep the materials and information secure and confidential and in accordance with the purposes and intent of the protective order.
- 5. All material and information designated as "highly confidential" in the possession of any entity or persons, other than in the Commission's file, as well as any notes pertaining to such information, shall be returned to Liberty or destroyed upon the conclusion of this case.
- 6. If a party disagrees with the "highly confidential" designation of any information, the party shall follow the informal discovery dispute resolution procedures set forth in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.090(8). If the party exhausts those dispute resolution procedures, the party may file a motion challenging the designation.

7. This order shall be effective when issued.
