### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and for its Recommendation, states as follows:

- 1. On November 4, 2025, Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. ("SNGMO") filed three (3) tariff sheets bearing an effective date of November 19, 2025, Tariff File No. JG-2026-0065, and an accompanying cover letter with supporting worksheets. The tariff sheets were filed to reflect changes in SNGMO's Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment ("RPGA") factors as a result of estimated changes in the cost of natural gas. Also included in this filing is the annual change to the Actual Cost Adjustment ("ACA").
- 2. The Commission issued an order on November 5, 2025, directing Staff to file a recommendation regarding SNGMO's request and corresponding tariff sheets, Tariff File No. JG-2026-0065, no later than November 13, 2025.
- 3. The change on the Total PGA rate applicable to SNGMO's Gallatin District service areas will increase to 50.59¢/Ccf from 36.27¢/Ccf. The Warsaw/Lake of the Ozarks District Total PGA will decrease to \$1.0125/Ccf from \$1.1356/Ccf. The Rogersville/Branson District Total PGA will decrease to \$1.0737/Ccf from \$1.1289/Ccf.
- 4. Staff has reviewed SNGMO's filings and determined that the rates in the proposed tariff sheets, Tariff No. JG-2026-0065, were calculated in conformance with SNGMO's PGA Clause. Staff does not oppose the approval of these tariff sheets on

less than thirty (30) days' notice. Such action is supported by SNGMO's Commission-approved PGA Clause allowing for ten (10) business days' notice for PGA change filings.

- 5. For reasons more fully explained in Staff's Memorandum, attached hereto as Appendix A and incorporated herein, the PGA and ACA rate changes should be implemented on an interim basis, subject to refund status.
- 6. Case No. GR-2026-0120, under which these changes were filed, was established to track SNGMO's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 2024-2025 ACA filing. Case No. GR-2025-0147 was established to track the Company's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 2023-2024 ACA filing. These rate changes should be made on an interim basis, subject to refund ending final Commission decisions in ACA Case No. GR-2025-0147 (2023-2024 ACA filing) and ACA Case No. GR-2026-0120 (2024-2025 ACA filing).
- 7. Staff recommends the Commission approve the tariff sheets in Tariff File No. JG-2026-0065 as filed on November 4, 2026, on an interim basis, subject to refund, for service on and after November 19, 2025.
- 8. Due to the limited time available to review the documentation supporting the ACA factors SNGMO submitted in this filing, Staff requests the Commission order Staff to submit its results and recommendations regarding the information in this ACA filing to the Commission on or before December 15, 2026.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons and those stated in Staff's Memorandum attached hereto, Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order approving SNGMO's tariff sheets filed in Tariff No. JG-2026-0065 on November 4, 2025, on an interim, subject to refund status; and further order Staff to file its recommendation SNGMO's ACA filing no later than December 15, 2026.

PGA Filing Effective Date November 19, 2025

**DATE:** November 13, 2025

On November 4, 2025, Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. ("SNGMO" or "Company"), filed three (3) tariff sheets bearing a proposed effective date of November 19, 2025, Tariff No. JG-2026-0065. In addition, SNGMO filed a single cover letter and supporting worksheets.

The tariff sheets were filed to reflect changes in SNGMO's Purchased Gas Adjustment ("PGA") factors as the result of estimated changes in the cost of natural gas for the upcoming winter season and changes to the Actual Cost Adjustment ("ACA") factors.

On November 5, 2025, the Commission issued its "Order Directing Staff Recommendation and Setting Time for Reponses". The order directs Staff to file its recommendation no later than November 13, 2025.

Gallatin District Total PGA rate will increase to \$.5059 per Ccf from the current Total PGA rate of \$.3627 per Ccf. Warsaw/Lake of the Ozarks District Total PGA will decrease to \$1.0125 per Ccf from current Total PGA \$1.1356 per Ccf.. Rogersville/Branson Total PGA rate will decrease to \$1.0737 per Ccf from current Total PGA \$1.1289 per Ccf

This filing proposes a Total PGA increase to the Gallatin District and a Total PGA decrease to the Warsaw/Lake of the Ozarks District and Rogersville/Branson District. The table below reflects these changes.

Case No. GR-2026-0120, under which these changes were filed, was established to track SNGMO's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 2024-2025 ACA filing. These rate changes should be made on an interim basis, subject to refund pending final Commission decisions in this case and ACA Case No. GR-2025-0147 (2023-2024 ACA filing).

Due to the limited time available to review the documentation supporting the ACA factors submitted in this filing, the Procurement Analysis Department ("PAD") requests permission to submit its results and recommendations regarding the information included in this ACA filing to the Commission on or before December 15, 2026. The ACA procedure involves the review of and true-up to actual gas costs.

The Staff has verified that the Company has filed its annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment. Staff has reviewed this filing and is not aware of any issue currently pending before the Commission that affects or is affected by this filing, other than those mentioned above.

Staff has reviewed this filing and determined that the rates on the proposed tariff sheets were calculated in conformance with SNGMO's PGA Clause. Staff is of the opinion that good cause for approval of these tariff sheets on less than thirty (30) days' notice is demonstrated by SNGMO's Commission-approved PGA clause allowing for ten (10) business days for PGA

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change filings. Therefore, Staff recommends that the following tariff sheets filed on November 4, 2025, and effective on November 19, 2025, be approved on an interim basis, subject to refund:
