Landowner Rex Findley called in to the hot line inquiring how the line would impact the landowners property. Agent Sherry Wahn returned landowners call and explained at the current time the line was set to impact the landowner to the west of Mr. Findley however since the design has not made it through final approval from the stated there is a chance it could change. Mr. Findley asked if trees would be removed. Agent Wahn explained the trees within the easement area will be removed and possibly danger trees just outside of the easement area if the tree is tall and could damage the line however since Landowner Findley was an adjacent landowner, the utility company would have to notify the landowner and compensate if the removal was necessary. Landowner Findley asked if the fence between the properties would be removed. Agent Wahn explained the fence would not be removed since the fence will be running parallel to the transmission line. Landowner Findley stated there was a plan to build a pond on the property, Agent Wahn stated the pond should not be an issue since the landowners land was an adjacent parcel. Landowner Findley asked if there would be a meeting about the easement. Agent Wahn explained the Town Hall meeting for Worth County was conducted in April. Landowner Findley stated the landowner was not informed of the meeting so Agent Wahn confirmed the mailing address was correct. Agent Wahn explained once the ruling and approval for the line is acquired, a new letter will be sent out informing landowners of the final route and if the landowner is impacted or not."
