Why can't you go out of your way to avoid people's houses? This path that connects the two lines in Worth County has not been approved by the landowners. We built our house on HWY Y for the view over the family farm. We do not want to look out our window at these or the radiation that comes from them. Following middle fork allows you to avoid going near anyone's house. This current path goes right between 2 new builds that built for the view on a generational farm. The farm owner has not signed any contract for this path. So knowing that the landowners will not sell rights, does that must mean eminent domain or what happens next?"
