Paul,

Can you let me know the entity name for your property? I cannot find Paul Kazak in our system, so I am assuming an LLC or something to that effect.

There will definitely be compensation to those landowners who are impacted by the project. We will present a complete easement package for review which will include acreage and compensation offers.

I'm not aware of any planned wind/solar projects that will interconnect into the line. That is always a possibility in the future.

The orange ""blocks"" on the area are wider study areas due to allow for additional routing possibilities based on some sensitivities in those areas. Additionally, at the time these study areas were generated, Ameren was unsure as to the connection point with another Iowa Utility at the border. We have since learned that Ameren will determine the border crossing location and the Iowa Utility will have to match up to Ameren's location.
