ATXI objects to this data request on the grounds that it seeks information related to matters which are beyond the scope of the grant of intervention to Mr. James Harding which was limited per the Order Regarding Applications To Intervene and Directing Filing Of Procedural Schedule issued May 7, 2025, to "the issue of routing concerns affecting [his] property," and as such asks for information that is not relevant and is unlikely to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. ATXI also objects to this data request on the grounds and to the extent that it requests ATXI to create data or information which does not exist and/or is not maintained in the form requested in the normal course of business.

Subject to and without waiving the foregoing objections, ATXI responds as follows:

ATXI consultants were pointed to the worthmo.devnetwedge.com website by personnel
from the Worth County Assessor's office and utilized that website to obtain assessor's
office records and information, including landowner information, between the dates of
May 21, 2024 and July 5, 2024 for tax parcels in Worth County, Missouri. The purposes
for which ATXI's consultants utilized the worthmo.devnetwedge.com website included
obtaining Worth County Assessor information for tax parcels identified as being directly

- impacted by the transmission line route proposed by ATXI in its application (also referred to as route DO-28) for the notice of application filing sent to landowners on July 5, 2024.
- ATXI consultants acquired parcel specific information from the worthmo.devnetwedge.com website, including mailing addresses of landowners, for the tax parcels in Worth County, Missouri.
- 3. Please see the file Harding DR 2 Attach (CONFIDENTIAL) for the Worth County Assessor's office tax parcel information that was downloaded by ATXI's consultant from the worthmo.devnetwedge.com website and uploaded to the consultant's property data system on the dates indicated for parcels where the owner(s) were identified as Mark Harding. Mark and Laurice Harding, James Mark Harding, and/or James Mark Harding and Laurice M. Harding. The exact date such data was downloaded from the worthmo.deventwedge.com website is not available (except for the tax cards with a date in the document header), but that date was typically the same date as the upload date.
