**ORDER APPROVING EXPEDITED TARIFFS**

Issue Date: December 22, 2015

Effective Date: January 1, 2016

Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed tariff revisions on December 11, 2015, to extend certain of their MEEIA cycle 1 programs to prevent any gaps in availability of those programs before new cycle 2 programs go into effect. The tariff revisions carry an effective date of January 10, 2016, but KCPL and GMO have filed motions for expedited treatment asking the Commission to approve the tariff revisions to take effect on less than thirty days' notice.

The Commission ordered that any party wishing to respond to KCPL and GMO's motions for expedited approval of its tariff do so no later than December 17, 2015. The Commission also ordered its Staff to file a recommendation by that date. On December 17, 2015, Commission's Staff filed its recommendation advising the Commission to approve the tariffs to be effective on January 1, 2016, as requested, and stating its expectation that

cycle 2 programs will go into effect by April 1, 2016.<sup>1</sup> No other party has filed an objection or response regarding the motions for expedited treatment or the tariffs.

The Commission finds that KCPL and GMO have demonstrated good cause to make the tariffs effective on less than thirty days' notice, since doing so will allow KCPL and GMO to maintain certain existing MEEIA cycle 1 programs until new cycle 2 programs go into effect. Based on its independent and impartial review of Staff's recommendation and the companies' unopposed motions, the Commission concludes that the submitted tariffs should be approved on less than thirty days' notice.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The proposed tariff sheets submitted under Tariff No. JE-2016-0151 by Kansas City Power & Light Company are approved, effective on and after January 1, 2016.
