STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, through counsel, and for its Status Report states:

1. On April 18, 2024, Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc. (Confluence Rivers) filed an application regarding the unregulated sewer assets of Barbara E. Rampone located in and around the Timber Ridge subdivision in Johnson County, MO. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) was ordered to file a recommendation regarding the application.

2. On September 23, 2024, Staff requested the Commission to suspend its order for a recommendation. The suspension was requested to allow Confluence Rivers to amend its application to address issues raised by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources regarding the proposed rates in the application.

3. On November 7, 2025, Confluence Rivers filed a *Motion for Leave to Amend Application* (Motion).

4. On November 12, 2025, the Commission ordered that no later than November 17, 2025, the Commission's Staff shall file a pleading indicating a date when it expects to be able to file its recommendation.

5. Staff informs the Commission that it expects to be able to file its recommendation no later than January 15, 2026.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests the Commission to set a date of January 15, 2026, for Staff to file its recommendation in this matter.
