## ORDER EXTENDING RESPONSE TIME

Issue Date: November 19, 2025 Effective Date: November 19, 2025

On September 15, 2025,<sup>1</sup> the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its *Staff Recommendation* regarding the application of Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) in this matter. On September 25, Staff and ATXI filed a *Joint Recommendation for Granting of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* (CCN) (Joint Recommendation). On September 25, the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) requested an extension to October 24 to file a response to Staff's recommendation. The Commission granted the motion, and Public Counsel filed its response on the deadline date, requesting the Commission impose two additional conditions on the granting of the CCN, besides those enumerated in the Joint Recommendation.

On November 3, ATXI filed its *Response to the Office of Public Counsel's Proposed Conditions* (ATXI Response). On November 13, Public Counsel filed a *Motion for Extension of Time*, requesting an extension to December 12 to file a response to the ATXI Response. The Commission set a November 18 deadline for responses to Public Counsel's motion and, on that date, ATXI filed its *Response to the Office of Public*

Counsel's Second Motion for Extension of Time, objecting to the December 12<sup>th</sup> extension but indicating it would not oppose an extension to November 26.

Public Counsel's requested extension to December 12 would allow it a total of 39 days to respond to the ATXI Response, whereas an extension to November 26 would allow a total of 23 days to respond. A November 26 deadline would still provide Public Counsel over twice the time to respond to ATXI's filing as the ten-day period to respond to any pleading provided for in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.050(3)(A). The Commission finds that to be adequate time for Public Counsel to respond to the ATXI Response and will, accordingly, grant an extension to November 26.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Public Counsel is granted an extension to November 26, 2025, to file a response to ATXI's *Response to the Office of Public Counsel's Proposed Conditions*.
  - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
