**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS IN COMPLIANCE  
WITH COMMISSION ORDERS**

Issue Date: July 8, 2022

Effective Date: August 7, 2022

On January 19, 2022, in File No. ET-2020-0390, the Commission approved a stipulation and agreement approving The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty's Transportation Electrification Pilot Program. The order authorized Liberty to file tariff sheets to comply with the Commission's order.

On April 6, 2022, the Commission issued its Report and Order in Liberty's general rate proceeding, File No. ER-2021-0312. The Report and Order authorized Liberty to file tariff sheets to comply with the Commission's Report and Order.

On May 18, 2022, per Liberty's request, the Commission modified the Transportation Electrification Pilot Program stipulation and agreement to align with provisions approved in Liberty's general rate case Report and Order.

On May 12, 2022, Liberty filed compliance tariff sheets, Tracking No. YE-2022-0254, in both files concerning the Transportation Electrification Pilot Program.

Those tariff sheets bear an effective date of October 15, 2022. Liberty subsequently substituted some of those tariff sheets on May 18, 2022, and May 27, 2022.

The Commission ordered its Staff to file a recommendation about the compliance tariff sheets by June 18, 2022. Other parties were also given until that date to file any comments concerning the compliance tariff sheets. Staff timely recommended the Commission approve the compliance tariff sheets. No other comments were received.

After reviewing the compliance tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds the tariff sheets comply with both the Commission's Report and Order in Liberty's general rate case and the orders approving and modifying the stipulation and agreement in Liberty's Transportation Electrification Pilot Program case. Therefore, the Commission will approve the tariff sheets to take effect on October 15, 2022.
