On October 24, 2025, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty filed the above-referenced application, proposing to construct a 250 MW combustion turbine generator.

The Commission directed notice and set a deadline for applications to intervene of November 12, 2025. Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri filed a timely application to intervene.
