The Commission opened this file for its Staff to report on the events related to the February 2021 cold weather event and the preparation and response by Missouri's electrical and natural gas utilities. In addition to Staff's report, the Commission will order Missouri's investor-owned natural gas utilities to present at a workshop additional information related to potential consequences and options to mitigate the impact of the February 2021 extreme cold weather event.¹

Each gas utility shall be prepared to discuss the following:

- What are possible solutions to rules and tariff language that may impede financial relief for the utility and its customers? This could include discussion of the potential extreme prices on PGA/ACA.
- What magnitude of a price increase could result? Could the period of recovery be extended? Would another mechanism such as an Accounting Authority Order (AAO) need to be available?
- Did the gas utility issue operational flow orders (OFOs) lead to penalties to customers? If so, what solutions may need to be considered if tariff language restrictions create extreme hardships for customers? Did the gas utility curtail customers and what impact did that have on the utility system? How did the utility work with its customers during the weather event?
