## ORDER *NUNC PRO TUNC*

The Commission is correcting its *Order Regarding Ameren Missouri's Request for Approval of a Large Load Rate Plan and Associated Variance*, issued November 24, 2025, nunc pro tunc pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.160(4) to correct an error.

On page four of the order under Revenue Sharing the Commission summarized the revenue sharing provision as follows:

**Revenue Sharing** – The Agreement provides that Ameren Missouri shall file a yearly Earnings Review Surveillance report. If that report shows that the revenues from large load customers exceed the amount of large load customers base rate revenues, such excess revenue shall be returned to customers in an amortization to be determined in a future rate case. Such revenue shall be used to benefit all customers of the electric utility, and excess revenue amounts above a fixed percentage shall be set aside exclusively for the benefit of low-income customers.

On December 1, 2025, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed *Motion for Order Nunc Pro Tunc or, Alternatively, for Clarification or Rehearing*. Ameren Missouri states that the Commission's summary leaves out a necessary step explaining how such excess revenue is determined. The Commission agrees.

The Commission's summary of the revenue sharing provision of its order approving the *Amended Non-Unanimous Global Stipulation and Agreement* (Agreement)

was meant to accurately reflect how the Revenue Sharing provision would work. The Commissions summary failed to adequately describe how revenue sharing would be calculated. Revenue sharing would be calculated as explained in paragraph 46 of the Agreement, and an example of such calculation is included in Exhibit D attached to the Agreement.

The Commission will correct the orders Revenue Sharing paragraph to reference paragraph 46 and Exhibit D of the stipulation and agreement, which explain the revenue sharing mechanism. Therefore, the Revenue Sharing paragraph on page four is corrected to read as follows:

**Revenue Sharing** – The Agreement provides that Ameren Missouri shall file a yearly Earnings Review Surveillance report. Paragraph 46 of the Agreement and Exhibit D, attached to the Agreement, explain and provide an example of the revenue sharing mechanism and the process to quantify any revenues to be returned to customers in an amortization to be determined in a future rate case. Such revenue shall be used to benefit all customers of the electric utility, and excess revenue amounts above a fixed percentage shall be set aside exclusively for the benefit of low-income customers.

This Order Nunc Pro Tunc corrects that Revenue Sharing paragraph in its prior *Order Regarding Ameren Missouri's Request for Approval of a Large Load Rate Plan and Associated Variance*.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The *Order Regarding Ameren Missouri's Request for Approval of a Large Load Rate Plan and Associated Variance*, issued November 24, 2025, is corrected nunc pro tunc as set forth in the body of this order.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
