1	The following proceedings began at 12:00 p.m.:
2	JUDGE DIPPELL: We can go ahead and go on the
3	record. Good morning, or good afternoon now. It is
4	November 21st, 2025. My name is Nancy Dippell. We're
5	here for a rulemaking hearing in Case No. OX-2026-0046,
6	In the Matter of the Proposed Amendment of the
7	Commission's Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.165 Relating to
8	Prohibition on HVAC Services.
9	A rulemaking hearing is not like a contested
10	case. We don't take sworn testimony, but we're here to
11	receive comments today on the proposed rule amendments.
12	I have Commissioner Coleman here in the
13	hearing room with me, and I'm not sure who I might have
14	online but other Commissioners may be joining us.
15	And since this is not like a contested case, I
16	won't be asking for regular entries of appearance. But
17	if any attorneys are present that want to make their
18	appearance, even if they are not making comments, they
19	may do so but we'll call those as we go.
20	Normally our rule says that we take comments
21	in a certain order; but since there's not many people
22	present to comment and the comments tend to vary between
23	supportive and suggested changes, we'll just go through
24	the parties as time permits as we come to them.

Since we're making a recording of this, I

would ask if anybody is in the audience that wants to speak they come to a microphone. I noted that we had a few people joining us online. If those people are wishing to give comments, I'll call on you and you can identify yourselves and give comments at that time.

If anyone is present or online, I would ask that you mute your devices so that we don't have bells and whistles during the proceeding. And I think that's about all my opening remarks. So I'm just going to ask if staff would like to begin with comments.

MR. STACEY: Thank you, Judge. Good afternoon, Judge. Good afternoon, Commissioner Coleman. Scott Stacey with Staff Counsel's Office here for staff.

Staff submitted proposed amendments to 20 CSR 4240-10.165 due to the passage of Senate Bill 4 Fair Competition Law. Staff submitted its comments in support of the amendment on November 14, and staff has reviewed Spire Missouri's comments that they filed on November 14 and agree that there's some -- that one section that they wanted to change in subsection 3 needed to be clarified. And after discussions, staff developed a response in the change to subsection 3, and that change is covered utilities shall develop a written disqualification process for all utility contractors engaged in HVAC services and shall advertise bid

1	opportunities to all such qualified contractors. That
2	change has been discussed with Spire and they were good
3	with that change. And I also have with me Kim Bolin and
4	Curt Gateley if there's any additional questions. Thank
5	you.
6	JUDGE DIPPELL: Thank you. Are there any
7	Commissioner questions for staff? I'm not seeing any.
8	Is there anyone else in the hearing room that
9	would like to give comments? I'm not seeing any.
10	Is there anyone online that would like to give
11	comments? Go ahead.
12	MR. ARIAS: Good morning, Judge Dippell,
13	Commissioner Coleman. My name is Antonio Arias on
14	behalf of Spire Missouri Inc. My address is 700 Market
15	Street, St. Louis, Missouri 63101. The company
16	appreciates staff's and the Commission's efforts in
17	proposing these amendments.
18	Spire is in support of staff's proposed change
19	offered today. I think it should be qualification
20	process, not disqualification process, but I believe
21	that's the only change that would need to happen.
22	Staff's proposed change with that additional change
23	would address Spire's concerns raised in its written
24	comments. Thank you.

16	in the room? Seeing none, I think that will conclude
17	this rulemaking hearing. Thank you all for your
18	participation. We can go off the record.
