Alderman Christine Wait asked Dixon a series of questions including whether Ameren would be using a construction work in progress (CWIP) agreement and how Ameren can justify ratepayers paying for infrastructure before a proposed data center is online.

Dixon explained that CWIP is an accounting process that allows Ameren to recover funds for infrastructure improvements before those improvements are energized. He said such arrangements have nothing to do with large load customers such as data centers.
