On September 25, the Staff of the Commission and ATXI filed a *Joint Recommendation for Granting of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* (CCN) (Joint Recommendation). On October 24, the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) filed a response to the Joint Recommendation in which requested the Commission impose two conditions on the granting of a CCN to ATXI in addition to the 13 conditions listed in the Joint Recommendation.
