CENTRAL JEFFERSON'S MAY STATUS REPORT

Comes now Central Jefferson County Utilities, Inc. (Company), and, as its May Status Report, respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission):

1. The Commission's Report and Order in this case directs that Central Jefferson file a monthly status report until the Commission is notified that all the transactions have been completed. Central Jefferson previously filed a Status Report on April 9, 2007.
2. On May 2, 2007, the Jefferson County Circuit Court issued its Judgment Amending Decree of Incorporation wherein it amended the Jefferson County Public Sewer District's Decree of Incorporation to allow the District to engage in the construction, maintenance and operation of common public water supply. A copy of the Judgment is attached hereto as **Appendix A**.
3. Also on May 2, 2007, a First Amendment to Sewer and Water Service Fee Agreement was executed by the Jefferson County Public Sewer District and Raintree Plantation, Inc. This amendment provides that by contract Mr. Kolisch will remain in the same position in the future for receiving refunds as if Central Jefferson's tariffs were to

remain in place, as required by Finding of Fact number 90. This First Amendment also addresses a contingency associated with Aqua Source that was mentioned in previous status reports. A copy of the First Amendment is attached hereto as **Appendix B**.

4. Central Jefferson understands that only one contingency described in previous status reports remains concerning the Tri-Party Purchase and Sale Agreement. Central Jefferson is awaiting one deed that should address the remaining title issues. Central Jefferson believes that it will receive this deed by the end of this week.


5. With this information, Central Jefferson had tentatively set a closing of this transaction for May 16, 2007. However, two events put this closing in jeopardy. On April 13, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed complaints against Central Jefferson in Cases Nos. WC-2007-0394 and SC-2007-0396 seeking the right to pursue penalties. Second, on May 1, 2007, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources filed a Petition for Preliminary and Permanent Injunction and for the Assessment of Civil Penalties in the Jefferson County Circuit Court.

6. The existence of these matters permits the other parties to the Tri-Party Agreement to terminate the Agreement, if they so desire. As a result, Central Jefferson does not know at this time whether or when the transaction will be completed.

WHEREFORE, Central Jefferson asks that the Commission consider this

Status Report to comply with the Report and Order in this case.
