REQUEST FOR COMMISSION ORDER

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and in support of this motion respectfully states as follows:

1. On December 15, 2025, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri” or “Company”) filed a *Motion for Expedited Treatment and Application for Financing Order* (“Application”). The Application requested permission and authority to issue and sell up to \$1,500,000,000 aggregate principal amount of traditional long-term indebtedness. The Company further requested that the Application receive expedited treatment in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(14), and that the Commission issue its order in this matter no later than February 13, 2026.

2. Staff is reviewing the Application and issued its initial data requests (“DRs”) on December 16, 2025. The responses to those DRs are due no later than January 5, 2026. Staff has discussed expediting the responses to its initial DRs with Ameren Missouri.

3. While Staff does not have a position at this time regarding the Company’s request for expedited treatment, once Staff has reviewed the responses to its initial DRs, Staff believes it will be able to take a position at that time. Staff further believes that it will

know when it can file its recommendation in this matter after it has reviewed the responses to the initial DRs.

4. In order for Staff to have the time to determine its position on expedited treatment and when it can file its recommendation, Staff requests the Commission issue an order directing Staff to make a filing no later than January 9, 2026, regarding its position on expedited treatment, and when it can file its recommendation in this matter. Staff will endeavor to make a filing earlier if possible, but no later than January 9, 2026.

WHEREFORE Staff respectfully submits its request as set forth hereinabove, and prays the Commission issue an order granting Staff's request.
