MOTION FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and in support of this motion respectfully states as follows:

1. On December 15, 2025, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri” or “Company”) filed a *Motion for Expedited Treatment and Application for Financing Order* (“Application”). The Application requested permission and authority to issue and sell up to \$1,500,000,000 aggregate principal amount of traditional long-term indebtedness. The Company further requested that the Application receive expedited treatment in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(14), and that the Commission issue its order in this matter no later than February 13, 2026.

2. Staff filed its *Request for Commission Order* (“Request”) on December 19, 2026, requesting that the Commission issue an order directing Staff to make a filing no later than January 9, 2026, regarding its position on expedited treatment, and when it can file its recommendation in this matter. Later that same day, the Commission issued an order directing Staff to file its recommendation in this matter no later than January 9, 2026.

3. As stated in Staff’s Request, Staff has been reviewing the application and submitted its initial 12 data requests (“DRs”) on December 16, 2025. As of the date of this filing, Staff has submitted approximately 20 DRs in total. Staff and Ameren Missouri

have been working together to provide responses in an expeditious manner, and Ameren Missouri has responded to 11 Staff DRs thus far. There are currently 9 DRs left for Ameren Missouri to respond to.

4. Based on the responses received thus far, the continued expedited responses to Staff DRs, and after meeting with Ameren Missouri on December 31, 2025, Staff has no objection to the Company's request for expedited treatment and believes it can file its recommendation in this matter by January 16, 2026.

5. Staff confirmed with Ameren Missouri that the Company has no objection to Staff's extension request to file its recommendation by January 16, 2026.

WHEREFORE Staff respectfully requests the Commission issue an order extending the date for Staff to file its recommendation in this matter to January 16, 2026, and any further relief deemed just and necessary under the circumstances.
