## ORDER SETTING AN INTERVENTION DEADLINE, DIRECTING A STAFF TARIFF RECOMMENDATION, AND SETTING TIME FOR OTHER TARIFF COMMENTS

Effective Date: January 6, 2026

On January 5, 2026, Everyg Metro, Inc. d/b/a Everyg Missouri Metro and Everyg Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Everyg Missouri West (collectively “Everyg”) filed tariff sheets to allow its customers to opt out of Time of Use (TOU) rates. Section 386.1100 RSMo, requires the Commission to issue an order allowing mandated TOU customers to opt out of TOU rates. The statute allows the Commission to issue such an order in a general rate case or a standalone tariff case like this one. Everyg’s tariff sheets bear an effective date of February 4, 2026.

The Commission will set an intervention deadline and direct its Staff to file a recommendation. The Commission will also set a deadline for any responses to Everyg’s tariff sheets.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any person or entity wishing to intervene must file an application to intervene no later than January 16, 2026.
2. Staff must file a recommendation about Everyg’s tariff sheets no later than January 16, 2026.

3. Any other responses to Evergy's tariff sheets must be filed no later than January 16, 2026.

4. This order is effective when issued.
