ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On November 6, 2020, Vearline Nelson filed two complaints with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Spire Missouri Inc., d/b/a Spire. The Commission consolidated those complaints under the above file number on December 4, 2020. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its report regarding the complaints on February 26, 2021, subsequently, the Commission ordered Staff to file a proposed procedural schedule on behalf of the parties.

On March 17, 2021, Staff filed a joint proposed procedural schedule on behalf of Staff and Spire. Staff made multiple attempts to contact Ms. Nelson to discuss the procedural schedule, but was unable to contact her.

The Commission will adopt Staff and Spire's proposed procedural schedule, but will add a prehearing conference to ascertain that Ms. Nelson is able, and wants, to participate in the evidentiary hearing via telephone.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following procedural schedule is established:

WebEx Prehearing Conference (Complainant will be mailed conference information, other parties will be emailed conference information.)	April 8, 2021
Last Day to Request Discovery	April 23, 2021
Stipulation of Undisputed Facts	May 20, 2021
List of Issues and List of Witnesses	May 24, 2021
Evidentiary Hearing	June 4, 2021
Briefs (At the Commission's request)	June 18, 2021

2. The parties shall appear for an evidentiary hearing at 9:00 a.m. on June 4, 2021. The evidentiary hearing shall be held by video and teleconference via WebEx. Participants shall appear at the evidentiary hearing telephonically via WebEx video and telephone conference. Interested persons who will not be actively participating in the hearing should contact the Regulatory Law Judge about attending the hearing. The link and access code to participate in the hearing via WebEx conference call will be emailed to all parties, and mailed to Complainant.

3. Those who require additional accommodations to participate in this hearing may call the Public Service Commission's hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 before the hearing.

4. All exhibits and presentations that any party intends to use at the hearing shall be emailed to the Regulatory Law Judge and counsel for each party no later than June 2, 2021.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
