**MOTION FOR EXTENSION**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, and for its *Staff Recommendation*, states as follows:

1. On April 18, 2024, Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc. (“Confluence”) filed an application to acquire the unregulated sewer assets of Barbara E. Rampone located in and around the Timber Ridge subdivision in Johnson County, Missouri.

2. On September 25, 2024, the Commission granted a request to suspend the filing of a recommendation in anticipation of the application being amended. On November 7, 2025, Confluence filed a *Motion for Leave to Amend Application*.

3. On November 18, the Commission issued its *Order Granting Motion to Amend Application and Directing Filing of Staff Recommendation* directing Staff to file a recommendation on the *Application* no later than January 15, 2026.

4. Staff is still working on completing its investigation and recommendation and requests an additional week to file its recommendation.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff respectfully submits this *Motion for Extension*, and requests the Commission grant Staff until January 22, 2026 to file its recommendation.
