NOTICE THAT TARIFF SHEETS WERE ALLOWED TO GO INTO EFFECT BY OPERATION OF LAW

Issue Date: January 20, 2026

On December 8, 2025, Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (Evergy) filed a *Notice of Stipulation and Agreement and Request for Variance* and a *Stipulation and Agreement* (Stipulation), stating that, following discussions and negotiations, all its industrial steam customers have authorized the filing of the Stipulation and support its approval by the Commission.

On December 19, 2025, Evergy filed a tariff sheet adjusting steam heat rates to implement the terms of the Stipulation. The tariff sheet was filed with an effective date of January 1, 2026, and assigned Tracking No. JE-2026-0077. On December 30, 2025, Evergy, the Staff of the Commission (Staff), and the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) jointly filed a *Motion for Order Recognizing Extension of Tariff Effective Date* in which the parties state that they are in agreement that Evergy should extend the effective date of the tariff sheet from January 1, 2026, to January 18, 2026, to allow further exchange of information and discussions amongst the parties. The effective date of the tariff sheet was voluntarily suspended by Evergy to January 18, 2026.

On January 16, 2026, Staff filed its recommendation that the Commission approve the tariff sheet to go into effect on January 18, 2026. Staff's memorandum detailed that

Evergy's customers have negotiated to set ongoing rates below what Evergy would request in a rate case. Staff was only able to evaluate cost of service at a high level due some adjustments made by Evergy that Staff was unable to audit and review. Staff's high-level analysis shows that Evergy's cost of service for its steam business is reasonably expected to approximate, or exceed, the revenue underlying the Stipulation.

Also on January 16, 2026, OPC filed its statement that after discussions, it does not oppose that tariff sheet taking effect on January 18, 2026.

The Commission finds the terms of the tariff sheet reasonable and that it will produce just and reasonable results and will allow it to go into effect. Therefore, the Commission hereby gives notice that Evergy's tariff sheet, assigned Tracking No. JH-2026-0077, went into effect by operation of law on the proposed effective date of January 18, 2026, as follows:
