STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its *Staff Recommendation* in this matter respectfully states as follows:

1. On December 1, 2025, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri) filed a *Tariff Revision* bearing an effective date of February 1, 2026, along with the *Direct Testimony of J. Neil Graser*, with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) seeking to revise its Energy Efficiency Investment Clause (EEIC) Rider in its tariffs. According to the testimony, the rates would be adjusted to reflect the actual and forecasted costs of Ameren Missouri's energy efficiency programs.
2. Staff filed its initial recommendation on December 29, 2025, in which Staff recommended that the Commission approve Ameren Missouri's *Tariff Revision* to its EEIC Rider. The Commission subsequently issued its order approving the *Tariff Revision* on January 9, 2026.
3. Ameren Missouri filed a substitute tariff on January 21, 2026. In its tariff filing letter, Ameren Missouri noted that it had discovered an error in the tariff rate tables within the EEIC tariff. Ameren Missouri further noted that this was the only error, and that it did not change the Summary Energy Efficiency Investment Rate (EEIR) components and the Total EEIR numbers; however, the value indicated in the Residential Net Throughput Disincentive/Projected Energy (NTD/PE) MEEIA Cycle 3 table has been corrected.

4. The Commission ordered Staff to file a recommendation regarding the substitute tariff filed on January 21, 2026, no later than 12:00 p.m. on January 23, 2026.

5. After reviewing the substitute tariff filed on January 21, 2026, Staff recommends the Commission issue an order approving the substitute tariff so that it can take effect on February 1, 2026.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order approving the below tariff sheet, as filed on January 21, 2026, to take effect on and after February 1, 2026; and grant such other and further relief as is just under the circumstances.


