The Missouri Public Service Commission is Granting the application to intervene ("application") that the Missouri Department of Natural Resources ("DNR") filed on January 20, 2010. The Commission set the deadline for filing a response at February 1, 2010. As of the date of this order, no party has filed a response in opposition to the application.

The application is subject to the following standard:

The commission may on application permit any person to intervene on a showing that--

- (A) The proposed intervenor has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case; or
- (B) Granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest [.2]

DNR cites its duties under:

Section 640.150.1, RSMo. for planning for energy resource development; analyzing energy management issues; consulting and cooperating with all state and federal governmental agencies on matters of energy

research and development, management, conservation and distribution; assessing the potential impacts on environmental quality; and analyzing the potential for increased use of energy alternatives and making recommendations for the expanded use of such alternate energy sources and technologies.³

Those considerations meet the standard for intervention.

- 1. The application to intervene filed by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources is granted.
