RESPONSE TO COMMISSION ORDER

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”) and for its *Response to Commission Order*, states as follows:

1. On February 19, 2026, the Commission issued an *Order Shortening Time for Comments or Objections* in the above styled case which ordered that “[a]ny comments or objections to Raytown’s tariff must be filed no later than February 24, 2026, at noon.”

2. Pursuant to this *Order*, the OPC now responds.

3. The OPC does not object to the proposed tariff sheets filed by Raytown Water Company, for which Staff has already filed a recommendation to approve.

4. The OPC notes, however, that there are terms included in the filed disposition agreement between Staff and the Raytown Water Company that are not included in the tariff.

5. The OPC does not believe this is an error and is not asking for any modifications to either the tariff sheets or the disposition agreement. The OPC is raising this point only to note that the Commission would need to issue an order separately approving and ordering compliance with the disposition agreement to
