ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On February 23, 1993, Working Assets Funding Service, Inc. d/b/a Working Assets Long Distance (Applicant) was granted a Certificate of Service Authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri. This Certificate of Service Authority was ordered not to become effective until the Commission approved the Applicant's tariff. Applicant was further ordered to file a proposed tariff within thirty (30) days.

On April 19, 1993, Applicant filed its proposed tariff reflecting the rates, rules and regulations it intends to use in providing its competitive services in Missouri. On April 19, 1993, the Applicant filed a letter requesting the effective date of the tariff be extended until May 19, 1993. A Staff recommendation was filed on May 14, 1993, in which the Commission Staff recommended that the Commission approve Applicant's tariff. Applicant is proposing to provide switched services including "1+" long distance services, 800 services and operator services. The Applicant's proposed tariff identifies all operator service requirements which the Commission has previously established for operator service providers. The tariff filed reflects the statutory and regulatory requirements which were waived by the Commission.

Having considered the Applicant's tariff and the Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff details services,

equipment and pricing offered to all potential customers, and that the tariff is similar to the approved tariff for other Missouri certificated interexchange carriers that provide similar services. The Commission has also found that the tariff sheets filed by Applicant on April 19, 1993 comply with the Commission's order and should be approved for service on and after May 19, 1993.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by Working Assets Funding Service, Inc. d/b/a Working Assets Long Distance on April 19, 1993 are hereby approved for service on and after May 19, 1993:
