## Missouri Water Venice on the Lake Distribution, Well and Storage System Update

Case No. WR-2024-0104

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### 1. Introduction

This report is provided as a status update on Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water) LLC's ("MO Water") Venice on the Lake water distribution system and associated water storage assets, consistent with commitments and reporting expectations established in the Stipulation and Agreement approved in Case No. WR-2024-0104. This update is intended to summarize the Company's current operational posture at Venice on the Lake, progress on inspection and maintenance activities, and ongoing capital planning efforts specific to this system.

### 2. Distribution System & Well Overview and Status

MO Water operates the Venice on the Lake water distribution system as part of its Missouri service territory. The system is managed through a structured asset management framework focused on maintaining reliable service, meeting health and safety standards, and addressing system-specific reliability risks.

Ongoing distribution system activities at Venice on the Lake include replacement of aging mains under the Owner Supervised Program (OSP) approved by Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MODNR) and services, installation of non-standard meter replacements, implementation of AMR/AMI technologies where appropriate, and evaluation of system looping and interconnections to enhance resiliency. Capital projects are prioritized based on regulatory requirements, operational risk, customer impact, and overall system reliability within the Venice on the Lake service area.

Specific projects completed as of the date of this filing include:

- AMR/AMI customer meters used and useful in 2025
- Drilling of a new well to serve Venice on the Lake in 2024;
- Replacement of 600 linear feet of backbone main along Sundown Rd in 2024;
- Construction of well house to control new well in 2025;
- Replacement of 1,450 linear feet of backbone main along Sundown Rd in 2025;
- Tie-in of new well/well house and looping/upsizing 600 linear feet of 6-inch main to new backbone in 2025;
- Installation and testing of on-site backup generation at new well site in 2026; and
- Testing and placing in service of Red Rock #2 well at Venice on the Lake in February 2026.

Specific projects scheduled for the remainder of 2026 include:

- Replacement of 1,250 linear feet of backbone main along Sundown Rd to complete link between Red Rock Wells #1 & #2;
- Design, permit and install interconnection between Red Rock & Honey Lane systems along Primrose Ln.; and



- security fencing around Red Rock Well #2 & well house.

### 3. Water Storage Facilities

MO Water maintains water storage facilities that support system pressure and operational flexibility for the Venice on the Lake system. Storage facilities serving Venice on the Lake are managed in accordance with applicable MODNR requirements and industry standards.

Specific storage related projects planned for the Venice on the Lake system in 2026 & 2027 include:

- Engineering, design and permitting for the new elevated storage tank on the Red Rock Well #2 site;
- RFP and awarding of contracts for the manufacturing and construction of new tank; and
- Construction of new tank to bring into service by end of 2027.

### 4. Asset Management and Capital Planning

Venice on the Lake distribution and storage assets are managed through MO Water's Asset Management and Capital Improvement Plan, which provides an overview system priorities and planned investments over a five-year horizon.

### 5. Compliance and Ongoing Coordination

MO Water remains committed to meeting the requirements of the Stipulation and Agreement in Case No. WR-2024-0104 as they relate to the Venice on the Lake system. The Company continues to provide updates to Staff through periodic meetings and formal filings as appropriate.

### 6. Conclusion

MO Water continues to actively manage the Venice on the Lake water distribution and storage assets to ensure safe, reliable service to customers. Through ongoing inspections, maintenance activities, and targeted capital investments, the Company is addressing system needs at Venice on the Lake while maintaining compliance with applicable regulatory requirements.
