SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO COMMISSION ORDER

COMES NOW Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. (“SNGMO” or “Company”), and, as its *Response to Commission’s Order Opening a Working Case to Review Currently Existing Utility Affordability Programs*, states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

On October 1, 2025, the Commission opened this working case to review existing utility affordability programs to allow representatives from the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and any other interested stakeholders the opportunity to review the currently existing utility affordability programs designed for low-income and senior residential customers and to make recommendations or engage in further dialogue.

The Commission’s Order Opening Working Case and Directing Responses (“Order”) further directed that regulated utilities with a customer assistance program respond by completing an attached spreadsheet and returning it to the Commission no later than November 14, 2025.

On November 14, 2025, SNGMO filed its initial response to the Order, detailing its Low-Income Weatherization Program in Appendix A.

On February 5, 2026, the Company met with Staff to discuss SNGMO’s low-income programs. Staff requested the Company revise Appendix 2 to include information for budget billing and delayed payment agreements. SNGMO’s response is attached as Appendix A-Revised.

WHEREFORE, Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission accept its supplemental response to the Commission's *Order*, attached hereto as Appendix A-Revised.
