

4. The Company has failed to pay Commission assessment for fiscal year 2026.² The requirement to pay the Commission assessment is identified in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-28.012(2)(A). The Company fails to be legally, financially, and technically qualified to provide service due to its registration expiration in 2015. Therefore, Staff requests the Commission cancel the certificate to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri.

5. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests a hearing.³

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully recommends the Commission cancel Twin City Capital, LLC d/b/a American Select's certificate of authority to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri.
