NOTICE OF CASE FILING

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "Company") and under 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1), and for its notice that it will file for an application seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN"), states as follows:

1. Ameren Missouri intends to file a CCN for an 2100-megawatt combined cycle, natural gas generation plant, to be located at West Alton, Missouri.
2. 20 CSR 4240-20.045 contains the requirements for filing applications for a CCN for electrical production facilities.
3. The issues likely to be before the Missouri Public Service Commission in this case may be any issue related to constructing new generation, including siting and Ameren Missouri's need for additional generation resources.
4. Ameren Missouri has had no communications with the Office of the Commission (as defined in 20 CSR 4240-4.015(10)) respecting this filing during the 90 days prior to filing this notice.
