ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Issue Date: March 11, 2026

Effective Date: March 21, 2026

On November 21, 2025, Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire filed an application and petition with the Commission pursuant to Sections 393.1009, 393.1012, and 393.1015, RSMo, and Commission Rules 20 CSR 4240-2.060, 2.080, and 3.265, requesting that the Commission authorize changes to the Spire Missouri East (Spire East) and Spire Missouri West (Spire West) Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS). Spire asked for incremental annual ISRS revenues for Spire East of \$14,036,781, and for Spire West of \$16,299,992, for a total increase of \$30,336,773. Spire updated its request with a December True-Up. The True-Up requested \$10,346,407 for Spire East and \$9,686,823 for Spire West, and total annual cumulative revenues of \$20,033,230.

Spire also filed a tariff sheet denominated Tracking No. JG-2026-0070 with its application, which bears an effective date of December 21, 2025. The Commission suspended the tariff sheet until May 20, 2026. Finally, Spire requested waiver of the Commission's 60-day notice requirement¹ for good cause.

On March 5, 2026, the Commission issued an Order Approving Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge. That order rejected Tariff Tracking No. JG-2026-0070,

and it also authorized Spire to change its ISRS as recommended in the Commission's Staff Recommendation filed February 19, 2026.

Spire filed Tariff Tracking No. JG-2026-0119 to comply with the Commission's March 5, 2026, order. Spire also filed a *Motion for Expedited Treatment* on March 5, 2026, and requested an effective date of March 19, 2026, for the tariff to go into effect. On March 6, 2026, the Commission directed Staff to file a recommendation by March 9, 2026. Staff filed the recommendation on March 9, 2026, agreeing to the tariff conditions and requested an effective date of ten days after an Order was issued. The Commission will now order the Tariff to go into effect on March 21, 2026, ten days after an Order is issued.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Tariff Tracking No. JG-2026-0119 is approved to become effective on March 21, 2026.
2. This order shall be effective on March 21, 2026.
3. This case shall be closed on March 22, 2026.
