SECOND MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”), and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to amend its procedural schedule ordered March 5, 2026, to extend the time for filing surrebuttal/cross-surrebuttal testimony to allow additional time for continued settlement discussions. For its motion, Ameren Missouri respectfully states as follows:

1. On March 5, 2026, the Commission issued its *Order Granting Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule ("Order")*. The *Order* extended the date for filing surrebuttal and cross-surrebuttal testimony until March 13, 2026, and the date for filing the List of Issues and Witnesses, Order of Opening Statements, Witness List, and Order of Cross-Examination until March 20, 2026.
2. As stated in Ameren Missouri's *Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule*, Ameren Missouri and Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") have reached an agreement in principle to resolve all their issues in this matter.
3. Ameren Missouri, the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") and Staff continue to discuss settlement and believe an extension of the time to file surrebuttal/cross-surrebuttal

testimony will aid in furthering the discussions in hope of reaching a unanimous stipulation and agreement.

4. Ameren Missouri has discussed with the Staff, OPC, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri, and Sierra Club (known together herein as "the Parties") an extension for the date for filing surrebuttal/cross-surrebuttal testimony until March 20, 2026, and the filing of the List of Issues and Witnesses, Order Openings, Witness Testimony, and Cross Examination until March 27, 2026. The Parties have indicated to the undersigned counsel that they have no objection to this request.

5. No other modifications to the procedural schedule are requested at this time.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri respectfully requests that the Commission modify the procedural schedule and extend the date for filing surrebuttal/cross-surrebuttal testimony until March 20, 2026, and the filing of the List of Issues and Witnesses, Order Openings, Witness Testimony, and Cross Examination until March 27, 2026.
