**Re: Notification of Acquisition of Assets of Delta Communications, L.L.C. d/b/a Clearwave Fiber**

Dear Ms. Dippell,

Delta Communications, L.L.C. d/b/a Clearwave Fiber ("Clearwave"), MCC Network Services, LLC ("MCC") and Metro Communications Asset Entity LLC ("Metro Asset" and together with MCC, "Metro") (collectively, the "Parties"), by undersigned counsel, hereby notify the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), of the transfer of certain assets by Clearwave to Metro (the "Transaction").

It is the Parties' understanding that Commission approval is not required for the Transaction. Accordingly, the Parties submit this letter for informational purposes only to ensure the continuing accuracy of the Commission's records. In support, the Parties provide the following information:

**I. DESCRIPTION OF THE PARTIES**

**A. Delta Communications, L.L.C. d/b/a Clearwave Fiber**

Clearwave is an Illinois limited liability company headquartered at 27 Artley Road, Suite 4, Savannah, Georgia 31408. The company is engaged in the business of constructing, maintaining, and operating fiber-optic networks and providing Internet and telecommunications services to residential, business, and carrier customers in Illinois and Missouri. Clearwave holds authority to offer competitive local exchange services and intrastate interexchange services in Illinois and Missouri.

**B. MCC Network Services, LLC**

MCC is the largest independent fiber optic network in Central Illinois and manages an all fiberoptic network across Illinois, into Indiana and Missouri. MCC offers a full suite of telecom services across enterprise and residential verticals. The services to carrier and enterprise customers include transport, cellular backhaul, wavelengths, dedicated internet, private line, and dark services for business and carriers. In addition, MCC offers superior multi-gig internet, voice, and video services to consumers and small to medium sized businesses ("SMBs") under the Conxxus banner

(MCC's Fiber-to-the-Premises ("FTTP") platform).

MCC holds authorizations from the Missouri Public Service Commission to provide Basic Local, Non-Switched Local Telecommunications Services, and Interexchange Telecommunications Service (Docket No. TA-2021-0326, effective April 18, 2021) and interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol ("VoIP") (Docket No. TA-2021-0325, effective April 17, 2021).

### **C. Metro Communications Asset Entity LLC**

Metro Asset is a Delaware limited liability company and an indirect, wholly owned subsidiary of MCC, with headquarters located at 8 S Washington Street, Sullivan, Illinois 61951. Metro Asset holds holds authorizations from the Missouri Public Service Commission to provide Basic Local Exchange Telecommunications Services (Docket No. CA-2026-0197, effective March 8, 2026), Non-Switched Local and Interexchange Telecommunications Services (Docket No. XA-2026-1099, effective March 14, 2026) and interconnected VoIP (Docket No. DA-2026-0198, effective March 4, 2026).

## **II. DESCRIPTION OF THE TRANSACTION**

On October 13, 2025, Metro CW Holdings, LLC ("Metro CW Holdings"), Clearwave Fiber LLC, and Clearwave entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement ("Agreement"), pursuant to which, among other things, Metro will acquire certain assets, customers, and business of Clearwave in Southern Illinois and in and around St. Louis, Missouri, and assume certain related liabilities. Although the acquired assets ultimately will be owned by Metro Asset, MCC will be the service provider to the customers served via the acquired assets.

## **III. PUBLIC INTEREST STATEMENT**

Parties submit that the Transaction described herein serves the public interest. The combination of the Clearwave business in Southern Illinois and St. Louis, Missouri with Metro's existing fiber network and operations will result in efficiencies through economies of scale and scope, which will strengthen Metro's competitive position. In particular, the Transaction will allow Metro and its affiliates to supplement its network, extending its reach and enabling the company to enhance and improve services to customers in the region. Metro will also be able to satisfy the connectivity needs of Clearwave's existing customers in the region, and enhance services throughout the region through greater investment in Metro's core markets. Combining the complementary footprints of Clearwave and Metro in Missouri will allow Metro to better compete with larger regional and national rivals, and to meet the increasing demands for broadband connectivity throughout the Midwest region. Metro and its affiliates have the managerial capability and a robust platform to realize this strategic goal and to bring competitive benefits to bear.

In addition, no adverse impacts to Clearwave customers being transferred to MCC are expected as a result of the Transaction. Clearwave and MCC, as applicable, will provide notice to affected customers receiving telecommunications and/or VoIP services that MCC will become the carrier of record following completion of the sale. Such notices will be provided in compliance with applicable FCC and Commission rules or as may be required pursuant to a service agreement or other contract. MCC will continue to provide high-quality services to existing customers without any interruption of service at the same rates, terms and conditions. The Transaction is not intended, or expected, to result in the discontinuance, loss, or impairment of service to any customer in the
