and for its Clarification of Previous Motion, states as follows:

1. On October 26, 2007, AmerenUE filed its Project Power On tariff and a Motion for Expedited Treatment (Motion).
2. The Motion represented that attorneys for Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) did not object to the tariff or to the Motion.
3. AmerenUE files this pleading to clarify that its conversations prior to the filing of Motion were with Staff members rather than with the Commission's legal staff.
4. Since the filing of the Motion, AmerenUE has spoken with Staff attorney, Nathan Williams, and Mr. Williams indicated that Staff does not anticipate filing an objection to the tariff or to the Motion.
