**ORDER AUTHORIZING TRUE-UP ADJUSTMENT
TARIFF TO BECOME EFFECTIVE**

Issue Date: March 18, 2026

Effective Date: April 1, 2026

On March 2, 2026, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a revised tariff sheet, Tracking No. JE-2026-0116, to true-up its Securitized Utility Tariff Charge Rider. That tariff sheet bears an April 1, 2026, effective date.

The Commission directed its Staff (Staff) to file a recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri’s true-up adjustment tariff sheet and also set a time for any other responses to the tariff sheet.

Staff filed a recommendation on March 10, 2026, stating that it had reviewed Ameren Missouri’s tariff revision pursuant to Section 393.1700.2(3)(e), RSMo. Section 393.1700.2(3)(e), RSMo, requires Ameren Missouri to, at least annually, file a petition or letter applying a formula-based true-up mechanism. This mechanism is essential for making prompt periodic adjustments to the securitized utility tariff charges. These adjustments are necessary to correct any over-collection or under-collection of charges and to ensure the proper and timely payment of securitized utility tariff bonds and associated financing costs.

Staff recommends that the Commission authorize Ameren Missouri's true-up adjustment tariff sheet to take effect on April 1, 2026.

No other responses to Ameren Missouri's tariff revision were received.

The Commission reviewed the tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff sheet should be allowed to become effective. The Commission will authorize Ameren Missouri's tariff sheet to become effective on April 1, 2026. Accordingly, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days so that this order will be effective concurrently with the tariff sheet.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following tariff sheet filed by Ameren Missouri on March 2, 2026, assigned Tracking No. JE-2026-0116, is authorized to become effective on April 1, 2026:
