ORDER and NOTICE

Friendship Village of West County (Applicant) applied to the Public Service Commission (Commission) on February 28, 1997, for a certificate of service authority to provide shared tenant services (STS) in Missouri under § 392.410 RSMo 1994<sup>1</sup>. Shared tenant services are treated as competitive and given minimum regulation under § 392.520. The Commission is of the opinion that the Staff of the Public Service Commission (Staff) should conduct an investigation into whether the Applicant meets the requirements it has established for STS. *GE Capital-Rescom, L.P.*, Case No. TA-95-125, Report and Order, issued October 27, 1995; *ActiveTel L.D., Inc.*, Case No. TA-95-274, Report and Order, issued December 21, 1995. If Staff makes a favorable recommendation the Commission will grant the Applicant a certificate of service authority and competitive classification without hearing unless a proper party intervenes.

The Executive Secretary of the Commission will send a copy of this order to the telephone company providing local exchange service in the location covered by this application. Anyone who wishes to contest whether

it is in the public interest to grant Applicant a certificate or competitive status must file a written Application to Intervene and address it to the Executive Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. A party wishing to intervene must serve copies of their application on the applicant, the applicant's attorney, and all other intervenors. This applicant's attorney is:

Any party may object, in writing, to an Application to Intervene giving the reasons for the objection. An objection must be filed no later than ten days after the Application to Intervene was filed.


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**


