**ORDER APPROVING SALE OF SEWER FACILITIES**

On this 14th day of February, 2025, the same being a regular day of this Court, and the date set by this Court for hearing on the above captioned action, and comes the Applicant, Consolidated Public Water Supply District #1 of Knox County, Missouri (the "District") by and through its attorney, David M. Brown.

The Applicant announces ready for hearing upon the same and Applicant presents evidence in support of its Application for Order Approving Sale of Sewer Facilities.


It is the finding of this Court that it has jurisdiction of the parties and of the subject matter of this action.

It is the finding of this Court that the District has entered into an Agreement for Sale of Utility System ("the Contract") dated September 3, 2024, for the sale of the Sewer Treatment Systems serving the communities of Baring, Hurdland and Newark, in the County of Knox, State of Missouri, to Central States Water Resources, Inc., a Missouri corporation (the "Purchaser").

It is the further finding of this Court that the Contract (i) provides for the sale of all of the assets of the District exclusively used or held for use in connection with the Sewer Treatment Systems, including all permits, contract rights, real estate, sewer service facilities, sewer lines, lagoons, disposal systems and equipment; (ii) provides for payment in full of all of the Revenue Bonds constituting a lien on the income and revenues arising from the operation of the Sewer Treatment Systems, and that the rights of all Bond Holders will be fully protected; (iii) provides for the provision of the necessary sewer service to each of the residents and property owners of the District connected to the Sewer Treatment Systems; and (iv) is in the public interest and in the best interest of the District and the residents and property owners of the District connected to the Sewer Treatment Systems residing in Knox County, Missouri.

**WHEREFORE, IT IS THE ORDER AND JUDGMENT OF THIS COURT** that the Agreement for Sale of Utility System ("the Contract") dated September 3, 2024, entered into by and between the Applicant (the "District") and Central States Water Resources, Inc., a Missouri corporation (the "Purchaser"), **IS HEREBY APPROVED**, and that the costs of this action be taxed against Applicant.
