**MOTION FOR EXTENSION AND FILING DATE FOR DIRECT TESTIMONY**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, and for its *Motion for Extension* states as follows:

1. On March 9, 2026, the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) issued an order, requiring the parties to this case to file a proposed procedural schedule by March 23, 2026. The Commission also ordered the parties to file available hearing dates for March, April, and May.

2. On March 23, 2026, Staff requested an extension to allow the parties to file the proposed procedural schedule on Friday, March 27, 2026. No parties objected to this request. The Commission granted this request on March 24, 2026.

3. All parties to this case met yesterday to further coordinate dates for a procedural schedule. In this meeting, the parties agreed to consider newly-proposed dates and continue to work toward filing one procedural schedule reflecting all parties’ availability.

4. In order to continue these discussions, Staff respectfully requests an extension allowing the parties to file the proposed procedural schedule on Wednesday, April 1, 2026.

5. While the parties have not yet reached a consensus on the procedural schedule, all parties agree that direct testimony will be open to any party wishing to file. The parties also agree to propose Tuesday, April 7, 2026, to the Commission as the ordered filing date for direct testimony.

6. All parties also agree to the extension request, and will endeavor to file the procedural schedule earlier, if possible. This motion is made in the interest of justice and without the intent to unreasonably delay these proceedings.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff respectfully submits this *Motion for Extension* for the Commission's consideration and prays the Commission grant further relief as it deems just and reasonable.
