**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION TO SUBMIT PROPOSED
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND SETTING DATE FOR
FILING OF DIRECT TESTIMONY**

On March 9, 2026,¹ the parties were directed to submit a proposed procedural schedule no later than March 23, later extended to March 27 upon the request of the parties. On March 27, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) timely filed its *Motion for Extension and Filing Date for Direct Testimony* (Motion).

The Motion states that the parties are continuing discussions regarding a proposed procedural schedule. The Motion, therefore, requests an extension for the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than April 1.

Additionally, the Motion states that all parties have agreed that filing of direct testimony will be open to any party, and that the parties have agreed to propose April 7 as the filing date for direct testimony. The Motion indicates that all parties agreed to the extension request.

The Commission finds the requested extension and date for filing direct testimony to be reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's request for an extension of time is granted. The parties shall submit their proposed procedural schedule, jointly if possible, no later than April 1, 2026.
2. Direct testimony, for any party that wishes to file it, shall be filed no later than April 7, 2026.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
